Your Pre- College Academic Record

- Advising will start with a review of your academic record. This information is important for academic planning.
- If you have taken or are currently taking any AP, IB, College Now or are in an Early College high school, it is important that you notify your academic advisor when you first meet with them. These classes could provide you with transfer credit and your advisor needs to be aware of this in order to provide accurate advice.

Credits for Courses or Exams Taken While in High School.

It is important that during your first academic advising session you inform your advisor if you have taken any of the following courses or exams.

- **AP (Advanced Placement)** - In order to receive any academic credit or advanced standing, you must have your scores reported to City College by the College Board. Our school code is 2083.
 - Note: Not all AP scores earn college credits. Consult the [AP equivalency chart](#).
- **IB (International Baccalaureate)**
- **College Now**
- **Early College**
- **Other Transfer Credits** – Submit transcripts of all institutions you have attended.

Transfer Credit Evaluation Services

- The Transfer Evaluation Services Team in the Office of Admissions evaluates all undergraduate coursework taken prior to enrollment at City College for students entering degree programs.
