Membership is by invitation only and open to all matriculated students in good standing in the Division of Interdisciplinary Studies at the Center for Worker Education

- students 24 years of age and older seeking full-time or part-time undergraduate degrees
- students who have completed a minimum of 24 CCNY credits
- students who have completed 12 credits or more in Liberal Arts/Sciences. (May include transfer credits to fulfill this requirement)
- students who have earned a cumulative GPA of 3.5 and above
