A. Admission Requirements for Senior College Program

Admission to the senior college program is conditional and includes the following requirements and provisions:

- Students must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.75 at the time of admission
- Students cannot have an INC grade on their transcript at the time of admission
- Total transfer credits granted toward the baccalaureate degree: 60 credits
- Minimum additional credits required at the senior college to complete a baccalaureate degree: 60 credits
- Minimum credits required for the baccalaureate degree: 120

D. ARTICULATION AGREEMENT FOLLOW UP PROCEDURES


