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Dean Mercado's Welcome Message

We at CCNY's Continuing and Professional Studies (CPS) will start the Spring 2025 academic year with enthusiasm for the possibilities and growth ahead. Our commitment to excellence and innovation remains unwavering. Per Scholas' 2023 report on "The Future of Tech in America" showed that 98% of surveyed 650 C-suite executives, 100 hiring managers, and 1,500 office workers agreed that "tech skills are likely to be essential across every work sector in the next ten years." There is currently a lot of conversations around Artificial Technology (A.I.). To stay at the forefront of job market demands and academic innovation, we launched two A.I. courses in the Fall Semester 2024 for individuals and students who want to explore A.I's role in the workplace. These two A.I. introductory courses align with rapid changes in the health care, technology, and cybersecurity sectors. In Spring 2025, we will return with CISCO Cyber Ops, CompTIA A+, and Google I.T. Support courses.

Our commitment to advancement of workers is evident in the expansion of course offerings in key field areas of healthcare, information technology, workforce-based ESOL and GED programs, and our English Language Institute (ELI) for aspiring college students. We are expanding ELI from our CCNY West Harlem campus to Wall Street, where international students and NYC residents can learn intensive English while taking advantage of the many learning opportunities downtown. While our ELI students choose CCNY for its excellent intensive English programming, they also recognize that New York City is the best city in the world to learn English.

Our Allied Health program remains strong. Since we introduced Electrocardiogram (EKG) and Phlebotomy Technician certification programs, our classes have been running at maximum capacity of 15-25. Our Allied Health programs have doubled enrollment from Spring 2023 to Spring 2024. We have partnered with Northwell Hospital (Northwell Flexstaff) to make available externships to our Certified Clinical Medical Assistant students and graduates. For 2025, CPS will offer three different scholarship options for Allied Health students. We partnered with MedReview to offer scholarships to students who would like to be medical billers and coders as well as auditors. Upon completion, they will have an opportunity to receive an externship with MedReview, possibly leading to employment. A very gracious donor has provided us with funds to offer full tuition scholarships to a few of our Certified Nursing Assistant students who would like to continue their career in the Allied Health field upon completion.

The synergy created through partnerships across departments and disciplines is essential for fostering a vibrant and dynamic academic environment. Our previous shared initiatives, such as The Community Scientist Institute with CCNY's Biology Department, The Charles B. Rangel Infrastructure Workforce Initiative, the OASAS-certified CASAC Training Program through the CCNY Psychology Department, the NYC Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) with Civil Engineering Professor John Fillos, and the Architecture Summer Career Lab with The Bernard & Anne Spitzer School of Architecture continue to provide career opportunities and a holistic educational experience for our students. Through collaboration, we maximize our collective impact as we contribute to the legacy of The City College of New York.

In 2025, we are also excited to launch two more grants to help our communities and to make our courses free of charge. Our new CPS Associate Director Bino Realuyo, lead grant writer, partnered with Paul Shively, Director of CLIP at BMCC and submitted a grant proposal to Small Business Services (SBS) to deliver a 3-year Vocational English as a Second Language (VESL) program, in collaboration with restaurant employers, to 150 incumbent food service workers with limited English proficiency to learn ESOL. Our new funding includes curriculum development, program delivery, and wrap-around supportive services, and an opportunity to elevate the economic lives of one of the most overlooked segments of our working population. We have also received a grant from the Department of Labor (DOL) to offer several Allied Health courses such as Certified Clinical Medical Assistant, Medical Interpreter, EKG and Phlebotomy Technician for free with all materials included to underemployed and unemployed individuals. This will allow our students to receive training at no cost and enhance career prospects.

How to Register

Please register online. Our catalog has QR codes that link to our CPS website and course pages.

You must have an account with us in order to register. Please visit our website ccny.cuny.edu/cps and click Registration in the menu. Once in our registration page, click "Create Account" to create an account on our system that will allow you to register and add courses to your cart. Now you're ready to checkout!

Enrollment Requirement

CPS courses are accessible and open to the public. They are available in various formats and modalities: in-person, hybrid, online synchronous (e.g. in real time on Zoom), and online asynchronous (e.g. discussion boards). This flexibility allows our students to align their learning goals with their preferred learning mode. Enrollment at CCNY is not required to take our non-credit courses. However, a high school or HSE diploma is required to enroll in most of our certificate programs.

Payment Plans

Students can apply for a <u>payment plan</u> for open courses with a tuition cost of \$500 or more. A 50% of tuition deposit plus a non-refundable \$25 registration fee are required to enroll in a payment plan. An additional 10% fee will be charged to the tuition fee when selecting the payment plan option. Refund Policy

Refund requests must be submitted in writing via email at least five business days before the first day of class. A 100% refund, including the registration fee, will be issued if CPS cancels a course. If the student withdraws at least five business days before the first day of class, a 100% refund will be issued (less the \$25 registration fee). Refunds for one- or two-day workshops are only issued if the class is canceled. Be advised that non-attendance does not constitute a withdrawal or request for a refund. It is important to note that refunds are not issued after the first class session.

Refund requests are processed within approximately 6 to 8 weeks upon receipt and approval by CPS. Credit card refunds are credited to the card used for registration. Payments made by money orders and business checks are refunded via a mailed check.

Certificate Program Requirements

Our certificate programs are designed to equip individuals with the appropriate level of skills in the least amount of time possible to prepare for the workforce. Discounts

Senior citizens 60 years or older receive a discount of \$25 applied towards the \$25 registration fee for any open course costing \$99 or more (except computer courses). CCNY faculty, staff, students, and CCNY Alumni Association members receive a 10% course discount (exclusions may apply). A 10% discount on tuition is also available when your referral registers for a course of equal or greater value. Once eligible, you must present a valid ID confirming your current CCNY affiliation. Discounts cannot be combined with any other offers.

Course Date Changes & Course Cancellations

Continuing and Professional Studies courses are subject to a minimum enrollment. We reserve the right to cancel any class that does not meet the minimum registration required. If a course is canceled, students will receive a full refund. All course dates are subject to change as deemed necessary by CPS.

Classroom Location

Students enrolled in on-campus classes will receive an email with classroom information within one week of the course start date.

Incomplete (INC) Grades Policy

The grade of "INC" (incomplete) is temporary and given by the instructor with the following guidelines:

When the student has been consistent with passing coursework, and the instructor acknowledges the student can successfully complete the course requirements by the last day of the eighth week, or its equivalent in calendar time, of the following semester. The student must provide an acceptable and documented reason for not completing the coursework on time.

If the student does not submit the coursework accordingly, the grade will change to an "F" (Fail), and the student will forfeit the possibility of changing the incomplete status. The "F" grade will be permanent on the student record unless the instructor has submitted a passing grade. The Office of Continuing and Professional Studies will convert temporary "INC" grades to "F" by the ninth week of the following semester.

Grants and Scholarships

Career Success Scholarship: The Helena Rubenstein Foundation has long supported Continuing Education students at CUNY who pursue career advancement through education and training. Students who need tuition assistance can apply for the Helena Rubenstein Career Success Scholarship, which is available to cover up to 90% of a certificate program's tuition fees. Scholarship availability is limited and decisions are made by the CUNY office. Application begins on October 2024 for the Spring 2025 semester.

Free GED/ESOL Courses: For over two decades, the CPS grant-funded Adult Education Program at CCNY has served adult learners by providing tuition-free classes that prepare its students to gain access to higher education, pursue post-secondary training, and build their knowledge base to secure employment and achieve financial independence. These program efforts continue to strengthen the Harlem community and the greater New York area.

We offer General Education Development (GED) preparation classes for students to obtain a High School Equivalency (HSE) Diploma, and English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) courses that help non-English speakers achieve competency in reading, writing, speaking, and comprehension of the English Language. Additionally, students receive college and career advisement, job readiness training, and job placement assistance. The classes are available in the morning and evening on weekdays. Students must first attend an orientation and take a placement test before registration. Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Please complete the waiting list form below:

The CUNY Upskilling Scholarship: This grant-funded scholarship by the NYS Department of Labor aims to provide no-cost, relevant, short-duration virtual-based training to assist individuals with professional development, improve their skills, and meet NYS job demand in high-growth industries. If a particular course receives this grant, the course webpage and online registration form will include the information.

To participant, applicants must meet the eligibility requirements, as per the NYS Department of Labor: (1) Be legally permitted to work in the U.S., (2) be a New York resident, (3) be unemployed or underemployed, and (4) be able to provide a Social Security Number as part of the application.

Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA)

This 130-hour certificate provides the necessary knowledge and skills to become a nationally certified nursing assistant.

Course topics include Anatomy and Physiology, Basic Life Support, and the Fundamentals of Patient Care. Students will learn how to assist patients with daily living tasks by providing primary care services, such as bedmaking, grooming, and measuring vital signs.

We are a NYS Education (NYSED) approved learning format, consisting of online synchronous classroom instruction and a 30-hour in-person clinical externship at a nursing facility. Students are assigned to a clinical externship in a nursing home during the program's final 4 to 6 weeks.

Certified Nursing Assistants (CNAs) work under the supervision of a registered nurse (RN), licensed practical nurse (LPN), physician assistant (PA), nurse practitioner (NP), medical doctor, or other supervisory staff in a healthcare facility.

Medical Interpreter





The Medical Interpreter Certificate Program offers a comprehensive learning approach to becoming a professional medical interpreter. The curriculum covers the Code of Ethics, Standards of Practice, hospital regulations, and cultural competence. It provides practice of the necessary skills and techniques to master consecutive and simultaneous interpretation and sight translation. It imparts knowledge of medical terminology and basic principles of anatomy and physiology.

As many hospitals now rely on telephone interpreters to assist patients, CCNY's has developed the only curriculum incorporating telephonic interpretation and role play. Students also receive targeted assistance with resume writing, interview skills, and career development.

Students will also prepare for the National Certification exam and obtain live sessions by our certified instructor.

CCMA Certified Clinical Medical Assistant

This 320-hour hybrid course prepares students to work as multi-skilled health professionals and perform administrative and designated clinical duties under the direction of a physician.

Administrative tasks may include scheduling appointments, managing medical records, billing, and coding for insurance and patient invoices. And clinical duties may include, take and record vital signs and medical histories, preparing patients for examinations, drawing blood specimens, and administering medications as directed by a physician.

Topics in this course include medical terminology, anatomy and physiology, clinical practice, EKG and phlebotomy, vital Signs, CPR, business practice, and job readiness.

Students that successfully finish the course will obtain accreditation and be able to take the national certification exam through the NHA.

Certified Billing and Coding Specialist



This 170-hour online synchronous course includes submitting billing data and following up on claims with health insurance companies to receive payment for services rendered by healthcare providers.

This course prepares you to work as a Certified Medical Billing and Coding Specialist (CBCS) in outpatient medical facilities, such as physicians' offices, clinics, hospitals, auditing companies, and other related facilities.



This course is divided into two parts: (1) Medical Terminology, Anatomy and Physiology, Medical Coding, Revenue Cycle Management, and Health Insurance, and Legal; and (2) Compliance Responsibility. Students will accurately apply coding principles to assign codes based on the human body systems in medical billing and coding.

All instructors are CBCS National Healthcare Association (NHA) Certified: AAPC-CPC and CPC-I, with at least ten years of experience as coders and coding instructors. Upon completion, students are encouraged by the NHA Career Association to take the CBCS certification exam.

In collaboration with the Psychology Department of the Colin Powell School for Civic Leadership at CCNY, we provide the NYS OASAS-certified CASAC Training Program. This program offers ten (10) OASAS-approved courses that meet the NYS 350 hours of education training required to obtain the CASAC-Trainee credential.

Topics include:

- The psychopharmacological and physiological aspects of drugs, signs, symptoms, and stages of alcoholism, individual and group counseling skills, the ethics of confidentiality, family treatment, and multicultural issues.

We are funded by the NYS Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) which allows us to offer adult education classes tuition-free. In order to participate, adult students must be: (1) 19 years old or older, (2) a NYS resident, and (3) available for employment.

Our GED Preparation classes prepare students to pass the GED (General Educational Development) Exam leading to a High School Equivalency (HSE) Diploma as well as building students skills for success in college and the workplace. We are a combined workforce and ESOL program funded by the New York State WIOA program. The program helps non-native English speakers develop proficiency in grammar, reading, listening, speaking and writing skills as well as building students skills for success in the workplace.

Flags may be used at intersections, where the back-side message is inappropriate for opposing traffic, or where conditions such as high wind make using a paddle impractical. 


