

**PERMISSION**  
**FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS**  
**TO TAKE A GRADUATE COURSE**

To be allowed to take graduate courses, an undergraduate student **MUST be a senior^ with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75^^**, and the student must receive the permissions below (See Part II). Prior to taking the course, it is the student’s responsibility to consult with the general advisor for his or her undergraduate major to make sure that the course will count for the “undergraduate purpose” which he or she indicated on this form (See Part I).

~ **In general (except for the Accelerated 4+1 programs)**, please note that an undergraduate student at The Grove School can take engineering/computer science graduate courses for graduate credit if the course WILL NOT be used towards his or her undergraduate degree (*additional charges may apply*)\*. Students who plan to take a graduate course for graduate credit should consult with Grove’s Graduate School at [graduateengineering@ccny.cuny.edu](mailto:graduateengineering@ccny.cuny.edu) (or the applicable department graduate advisor) prior to completing this form and enrolling for the graduate course in order to get written confirmation that the course indicated can be applied towards the student’s future graduate degree (including a time line on the applicability of the course towards the student’s future graduate degree requirements). Admissions into an applicable 4+1 program after taking (a) graduate course (s) as an undergraduate student does not automatically mean that such graduate course (s) can apply towards the 4+1 program (unless explicitly approved to this effect by Grove’s Graduate Dean).
